The Parent Advisory Council (PAC) provides a voice & acts as a point of resource & support for our parent community. All Inman parents & guardians are automatically members.

We need new volunteers!

The PAC executive organizes parent, community and fundraising activities. We also work with the school administration on parent concerns.

All positions will be up for nominations and voting. These 3 roles require new candidates as the parents will be going to Cascade next year.



President (vacant Sept 2023)

Time commitment: 2-3 hours/month

- Chairs monthly PAC meetings
- Oversees PAC activities
- Sign cheques for PAC activities



Vice President (VP) (vacant Sept 2023)

Time commitment: 2-3 hours/month

- Fills in for PAC President
- Oversees PAC activities
- Sign cheques for PAC activities



District PAC (DPAC) Rep (vacant Sept 2023)

Time commitment: 2-3 hours/month

- Takes notes at DPAC meetings and share out any DPAC-related activities and resources at Inman PAC meetings

Why do we need all positions filled?

If PAC positions are not filled, PAC loses out on \$7000 in government gaming grant!

PAC President and VP positions are essential to the PAC! They are key signing persons for all PAC cheques and approvals.

If the DPAC Rep position is not filled, Inman loses out on important ongoing conversations within the District.

The Fundraising Coordinator is a key position to support all fundraising activities for the PAC.

Handover and training will be available to all new executive members and it's a great way to become more involved!
