Child Safety

As we enter the fall season and our days are shorter with more darkness due to weather this time of the year, kindly pay attention to the following tips to keep you and your children safe,

- Avoid wearing dark clothing,
 - Wear clothing with reflective strips or purchase the same to wear over clothing to enhance visibility to drivers, especially in low light conditions.
- Try not to look at your phone when crossing the street. We all operate under the premise that we have the right of way (*which is correct*), however, if a driver of a vehicle is not paying attention, it can lead to an incident with terrible consequences.
 - o **PRO TIP**: Practice safe crossing with your children,
 - When crossing, ensure you scan left and right,
 - Ensure the person crossing makes eye contact with the driver of any oncoming vehicles prior to starting their crossing.
- PARENTS DRIVING / DROP OFF & PICKUP: Please exercise caution, follow the signs (speed limits, parking restrictions, etc.)
